As 2019 winds down, and the holidays approach, we can look forward to the time of year for celebration and relaxation.


We have traditionally not held meetings in December so that we all may spend this time of year with our families, friends and loved ones. Oh, and also with our trees.



ALLAN SUGIMURA BLACK PINE

At our November meeting, DIBK held a Black Pine presentation and workshop led by Allan Sugimura. Members brought in their Japanese Black Pines to get styling advice and to work on their trees.

Alan brought in a variety of trees and discussed the development process and growing characteristics of each species. From various small cuttings, to trees that have been developed for over 20 years, the examples gave the attendees a good idea about how the tree development process works.

Allan discussed various development techniques such as wiring/bending of young material, as well as trunk and branch development. He wired a few seedlings and more mature trees and explained the process with each.

Allan then assisted everyone that brought in a Japanese Black Pine. He offered styling advice and growing tips for each tree.






