



## Fred Miyahara

Mr Miyahara has become a master on many aspects of bonsai especially in the area of grafting and the Japanese black pine. He has done thousands of grafts using shimpaku scions onto San Jose junipers, and Nishiki (cork bark), Mikawa and Awaji scions onto black pine stock

Mr Miyahara has many grafted shimpakus, and hundreds of black pine which he started from seeds. Fred learned from American and Japanese masters. Some of his teachers and mentors have been Mas Ishii, Ernie Kuo, Dennis Makishima, Bill Castellon, Kathy Shaner, Boon Manakitivipart, and Kenji Miyata. He has also learned a large amount by studying books and articles,



and most importantly, from experimenting on his own, the various methods and techniques. Mr Miyahara is regarded as one of the best black pine experts in southern California.

Fred is currently the vice president and curator of Japanese Friendship Garden in Balboa Park. In addition, he is a professional black pine pruner.
