




2012 Dai Ichi Club Annual Auction





People came early to preview the items that would be auctioned.








Gary Lai did a great job as auctioneer encouraging people to increase their bids to get the items they really wanted while also supporting the club.








Some of the happy customers that got great deals on some great trees, pots and books.










The donated auction trees helped the club raise money.


