

Bonsai Tip from Jim Tatsukawa – August 1993: Dai Ichi Newsletter

It is now full summer season; most bonsai have reached their maximum growth for this year. Watch for wiring that is cutting into the tree during the past couple of months. It is very important that the trees are periodically rotated to insure even growth. If possible create micro climate for the different species. Conifer is able to withstand full sun whereas Azaleas, Maples, and Ume do better when grown in filtered sunlight. Although the weather in So. California has been rather temperate during the past couple of months, there will be some very hot and dry days in August and September. Water each bonsai separately as different species require varied amounts of water. A "shot" of high phosphate fertilizer at this time will encourage more fruit and flowers during the coming year.


